Spencer Overton is the President of the Joint Center for Political and Economic Studies, which was founded in 1970 and is America's Black think tank. Spencer is also a tenured professor at GW Law School in Washington, DC, and is the author of the book "Stealing Democracy: The

New Politics of Voter Suppression" and several academic articles and popular commentaries on voting rights, race, and public policy.

Arturo Vargas is the CEO of the National Association of Latino Elected and Appointed Officials (NALEO) Educational Fund, a national nonprofit, non-partisan organization working to strengthen American democracy by promoting the full participation of Latinos in civic life. He also serves as the CEO of NALEO, a national membership organization of Latino policymakers and their supporters.
