I am proud to co-sponsor <u>House Bill 1122</u> to provide affordable broadband access to all corners of our state.


If passed the bill would:

- Establish a \$5 million Homework Grants pilot project;
- Invest \$85 million in the Growing Rural Economies with Access to Technology (GREAT) program;
- Expand health benefit coverage of telehealth services;
- Allow local governments' more authority to expand broadband to their citizens.

The COVID-19 crisis has made it crystal clear that we need better broadband service. Small businesses and farmers need it to serve global markets. Students need it for school work. Citizens, especially seniors, need it for telehealth services.

The demand for better broadband is immediate and is one of my top priorities in working on a State Budget.
