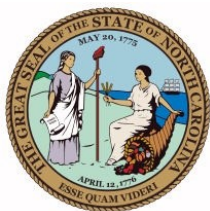

Peace. On tomorrow, April 29th, CVS Health will begin offering self-swab tests to individuals meeting Centers for Disease Control and Prevention criteria, in addition to state and age guidelines. Patients must register in advance at [CVS.com](https://www.cvs.com) to schedule an appointment. Patients will be required to stay in their cars and we be directed to the pharmacy drive-thru window, where they will be provided with a test kit and given instructions, and a CVS Pharmacy team member will observe the self-swab process to ensure it is done properly.

Tests will be sent to an independent, third party lab for processing and the results will be available in approximately three days.

Testing will not take place inside any retail locations, and CVS Pharmacy, HealthHUB and MinuteClinic will continue to serve customers and patients.

Testing can be scheduled online at [CVS.com](https://www.cvs.com) and take place in North Carolina at 55 select CVS Pharmacy locations. Employees participating in the test collection process will maintain safety using personal protective equipment and follow sanitization protocols after each test.

I am proud to co-sponsor [House Bill 1122](#) to provide affordable broadband access to all corners of our state.

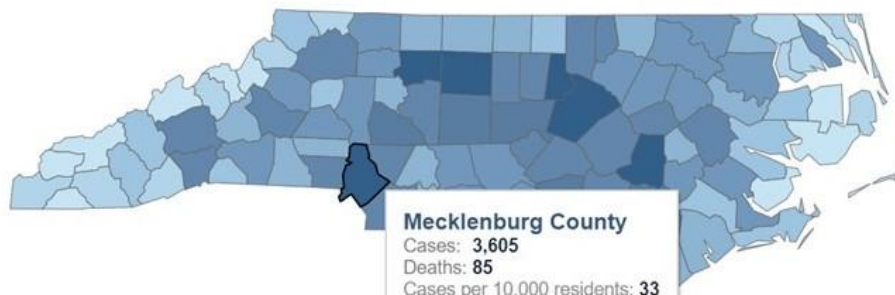
If passed the bill would:

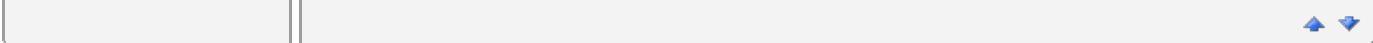
