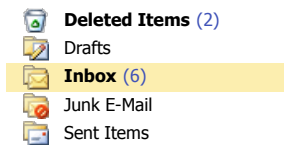
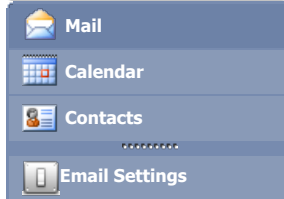

Good Afternoon,

In 2015 Central Piedmont received a National Science Foundation (NSF) grant that is aimed at increasing the number of under-represented minorities (URM) that receive bachelor's degrees in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) fields. One part of the grant is to offer a STEM Prep Program in order to give 11<sup>th</sup> grade, 12<sup>th</sup> grade and current Central Piedmont students an introduction to STEM topics at the college level. Students that participate in this program will be enrolled in non-credit courses that provide them with project-based experiences in mathematics and their choice of science, technology or engineering.

The summer session will be held for 4 weeks starting **June 22 – July 16, 2020**. The times will be on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 1pm- 3:30pm through a virtual platform through Central Piedmont so it will be important that students have reliable internet access.
