Qualified entries should also provide information that facilitates effective public policy making or improve the administration of an existing program.

The County Assessor's Office received an award for its Assessment Appeals at the Speed of Light! Program.

LUESA's Livable Meck Division won an award for its Voice of the Community program. The department's Code Enforcement Division also won awards for its Code Academy and Code Enforcement Inspections.
