The purpose of these trainings is to provide 16-24 years old residents living in Charlotte or attending a Charlotte-Mecklenburg School (CMS) with an opportunity to obtain training in resume development, job interview preparation, customer services skills, financial literacy, effective networking and workplace etiquette. **This training is also the first required step a student age 16- 18 years old must take in order to pursue the Mayor's Youth Employment Program (MYEP) eligibility.
