Although Election Day is Tuesday, November 3, there are several options for voting this year: absentee ballots, mail-in ballots, early voting, and voting on Election Day. In Charlotte, registered voters will have the opportunity to cast ballots for the North Carolina governor, Mecklenburg County Commissioners, United States president, and more.
