\$50 million on the ballot for housing will help provide well-maintained affordable housing for low- and moderate-income individuals and families in the Charlotte area.

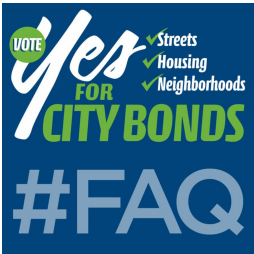
Efforts include:
