Shared Streets Span Even More of Charlotte

Charlotte's Shared Streets program has expanded to include 9 streets now, adding 3 new streets since August in the north, northwest, and northeast sides of the city. Stretches of Coker Avenue in Enderly Park, Holland Avenue and Isenhour Street in Druid Hills, and Ruth Drive in Shannon Park all have Shared Streets connecting their neighborhoods with limited car traffic.
