## Rep. Adams' October in Review

*Highlights include fighting for Charlotte workers, a plan to reform the Postal Service, and the second annual HBCU Day*

**CHARLOTTE – Congresswoman Alma Adams (NC-12)** had a busy October representing Charlotte and Mecklenburg County. Here are the highlights:

### COVID-19

- Adams [fought for economic relief](#) for Charlotte's struggling airline workers.
- Adams [continued to push OSHA to do a better job protecting American workers](#).
- Adams [wrote congressional leadership](#) to make sure HBCUs are a part of any COVID-19 relief package.

### Postal Service Reform

- Rep. Adams was [published in the Harvard Law School Journal on Legislation](#).

### Higher Education

- Adams [hosted the second annual \(and first virtual\) HBCU Day](#). Across platforms (Zoom, Facebook, YouTube, and Twitter) over 1,000 people participated.
- Adams' work as co-chair of the bipartisan Congressional HBCU Caucus [have made the schools a priority](#) in the 2020 campaign.

- The HBCU Caucus' Partnership Challenge has [accelerated private investment and interest](#) in HBCUs.
- Adams' editorial on the importance of HBCUs was published in [QCity Metro](#), the [Afro](#), and the [Milwaukee Courier](#).

### Honoring Legends

- Adams spoke on the House floor in honor of the late [Ruth Bader Ginsburg](#) and her former North Carolina General Assembly colleagues, [Sen. Katie Dorsett and Mary McAllister](#).

### Voting and Elections

- Adams hosted a ["Voting in 2020" town hall](#) to help 12th District residents answer their questions about voting.
- Adams [joined members of the NC delegation](#) to urge Facebook to stop misleading political ads on both sides.

### Trump Administration

- Adams [opposed Amy Coney Barrett's nomination](#) to the Supreme Court, stating *"There is nothing in this appointment for the vast majority of Americans except for pain and suffering."*
- Adams [expressed concern](#) with the Trump Administration's decision to end the census count early.
- Adams [called on the Department of Labor](#) to stop a proposed rule that would harm women in the workplace.

### Military and Veterans

- Adams hosted a [Military Service Academy Day](#) for prospective officers.
