Together, we are conducting **our community's first-ever study of Black-led, Black-benefitting (BLBB) nonprofit organizations**, as part of <u>The Bold Project</u>. The Bold Project is an initiative of NGAAP to strengthen Black-led organizations in Charlotte-Mecklenburg and to promote racial funding equity.

The aim of this research is to hear and learn from BLBB nonprofits, which function as the backbone of communities.
