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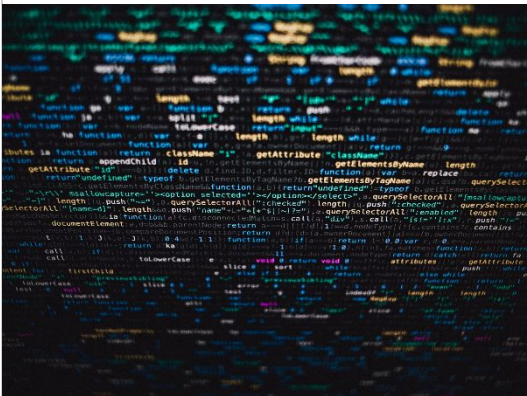
Knight announced the Knight New Work 2020 open call **winner**s in the performing arts and the 2020 Knight Arts **Champions**.



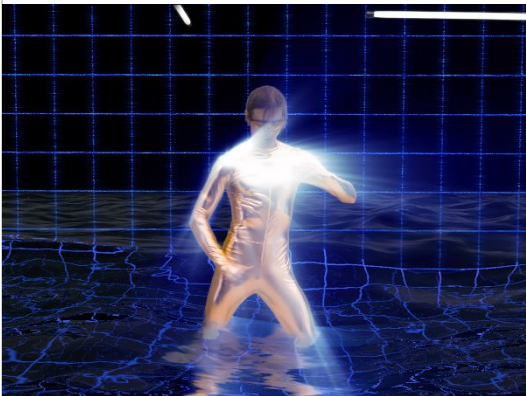
Mark Glaser explained how local nonprofit media **shined in 2020** in comparison to legacy media outlets.
