

1 of 4 12/27/20, 6:54 PM We know it's a tough time for everybody, but especially for the formerly incarcerated population, and their families, who have been hit even harder by COVID-19. CCT has adapted all of our in-person programs to virtual and phone supports so that we can continue to meet the growing needs. Here's how we have adapted our programs since March:

- <u>LifeWorks!</u> job readiness, retention and networking classes are now offered virtually and, to date, over 100 formerly incarcerated men and women have benefited.
- <u>Families Doing Time</u> focuses on providing social and emotional supports
  to families and improving literacy for children affected by a loved one's
  incarceration. In place of our in-person support groups and activities, staff
  has conducted over 70 one-on-one virtual/phone support sessions with
  families. Hundreds of bags of essential groceries and supplies have also
  been distributed.
- Our Center for Women is a 30 bed residential facility for women with 3
  years or less left of their prison sentences. Women are provided with the
  supports to ensure a healthy pathway to re-entry. Since DPS suspended
  work release, all residents have been at our facility 24/7 resulting in a
  need for increased staffing, meals, and technology.
