

Rep. Alma Adams Statement on Electoral College Vote Certification

Washington, D.C. – Today, **Congresswoman Alma Adams** (NC-12) released the following statement on the certification of the Electoral College votes from the fifty states and the District of Columbia:

"The quixotic Republican scheme to object to the Electoral College vote today is a distraction," **said Adams.** "It distracts from the 350,000 Americans who have died from COVID-19, and the tens of millions of families that desperately need assistance.
