Congresswoman Alma Adams represents North Carolina's 12th Congressional District (Charlotte, Mecklenburg County). She serves on the House Financial Services Committee, on the House Committee on Education and Labor as the chair of the Workforce Protections subcommittee, and on the House Agriculture Committee as Vice Chair. In 2015, she founded the Adams Hunger Initiative, which brings together local stakeholders on a quarterly basis to empower agencies and organizations fighting hunger in our community.
