Free COVID-19 Home Disinfecting for Seniors

Mecklenburg County, NC - Mecklenburg County's Department of Social Services (DSS) has partnered with Bio-One to offer a free, one-time COVID-19 professional disinfecting service to residents who are 60 years of age or older.

Bio-One will apply a CDC/EPA-approved chemical to all surfaces, doorknobs, handles, light switches and high traffic areas of the home. The chemical is safe for pets and children.

Participants must be:

- A resident of Mecklenburg County

- 60 years of age or older
- Able to leave their home for approximately one hour while services are rendered.

While there is no cleaning method that guarantees total elimination of the virus, Bio-One's cleaning protocol can help reduce the spread and threat of coronavirus.
