As you may know, next week is **Black Maternal Health Week**. The week was created by a joint Congressional resolution to bring attention to the Black maternal mortality and morbidity crisis.

Congresswoman Alma Adams is the co-founder and co-chair of the **Black Maternal Health Caucus**, and earlier this year she and Caucus co-chair Rep. Lauren Underwood introduced the **Black Maternal Health Momnibus Act of 2021**, a twelve-bill package designed to address this crisis. Since the Momnibus was first introduced last year, state legislators and leaders across the country have created their own state level plans to address the crisis.

Rep. Adams is hosting a press call at 10:00 AM ET on Monday, April 12 with many of the legislators who are working to tackle this problem.
