Rep. Alma Adams Statement on Vice President Harris' Visit to North Carolina in Support of President Biden's American Jobs Plan

Greensboro, N.C. – Congresswoman Alma Adams (NC-12) released the following statement on Vice President Kamala Harris' visit to North Carolina in support of President Joe Biden's American Jobs Plan:

*“A once-in-a-century crisis calls for once-in-a-century ideas, and that's what Vice President Harris spoke about today,” **said Adams.** “However, the Vice President talked about something more fundamental than that - she talked about the importance of a good job.
