
Fine Free Initiative

- Customers no longer charged fines on late (or overdue) materials





- Official re-name on April 25, 2020
- Helped desegregate CML in 1956
- Coordinated bookmobile for Negro Services
- Ms. Westbrooks was the first
 African American supervisor having multiple libraries reporting to her in NC.
