

We are asking the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Board of Education to do the following:

1. That CMS commit to following the law as defined by the North Carolina Supreme Court to guarantee each student the right to receive a “Sound Basic Education,” as enumerated in the *Leandro* decision.
2. That CMS re-establish the Equity Committee and amend the Equity Policy to include research-based instruction and intervention standards.
3. That CMS provide an annual report to the community on the number of students receiving a high school diploma endorsement as defined by the North Carolina State Board of Education.
4. That CMS expands efforts for technical/vocational education that includes building trades skills.
5. That CMS primarily report academic performance by the standard of Career and College Readiness. This standard is referred to in the Opportunity Task Force Report as a key indicator of economic mobility.
