We are asking the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Board of Education to do the following:

- 1. That CMS commit to following the law as defined by the North Carolina Supreme Court to guarantee each student the right to receive a "Sound Basic Education," as enumerated in the *Leandro* decision.
- 2. That CMS re-establish the Equity Committee and amend the Equity Policy to include research-based instruction and intervention standards.
- 3. That CMS provide an annual report to the community on the number of students receiving a high school diploma endorsement as defined by the North Carolina State Board of Education.
- 4. That CMS expands efforts for technical/vocational education that includes building trades skills.
- 5. That CMS primarily report academic performance by the standard of Career and College Readiness. This standard is referred to in the Opportunity Task Force Report as a key indicator of economic mobility.
