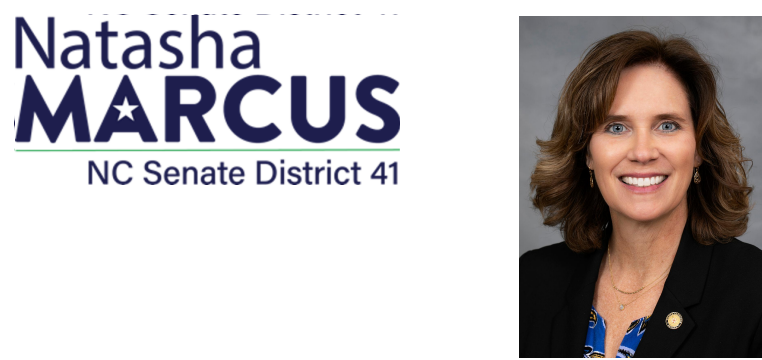

NCGA Public Hearings on
Proposed State Legislative and Congressional Maps

The Joint Redistricting Committee of the NCGA will have **public hearings to receive feedback on proposed Congressional and State Legislative district maps TODAY, Monday, October 25th and Tuesday, October 26th**. Each day, there will be an in-person hearing in Raleigh at 3pm, where the committee will hear comments in person and from the satellite locations. Additionally, each day at 5:30pm there will be an entirely virtual hearing via WebEx for folks who prefer that option.

The 3pm meetings on 10/25 and 10/26 are in Raleigh for public comment in person plus satellite locations at two campuses, where the public can speak to the committee remotely. The details and signup links for the hybrid in-person/virtual hearings are here:

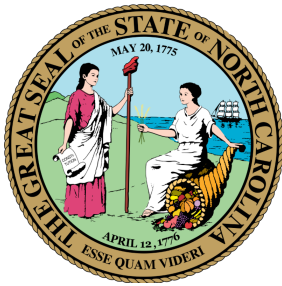
