As you might be aware, Mecklenburg County is currently looking for resident input to help shape the BOCC's funding priorities next year.

For the fourth year in a row, the County is offering its [Resident Budget Priority Survey](#) as a way for you to share your input on what matters most to you before the budget is finalized in June. The survey is open now through Dec. 20, 2021. You may take the survey by clicking [here](#) or by visiting [MeckNC.gov](#). Paper copies are also available in English and Spanish at County libraries and recreation centers.

The survey features eight County-funded areas and allows you to rank the areas in the order you feel is most important. You can also provide feedback on categories you feel are *overfunded* or *underfunded*. Results will be shared with the Board of County Commissioners in January.

County Manager Dena R. Diorio will use the results to assist with funding decisions for services such as affordable housing and homeless services, Public Health, Park and Recreation, MECK Pre-K, workforce development, court buildings and jails, environmental services and more.
