## Another Election Delay

As you may have seen last week, the already-delayed election for Charlotte City Council has been delayed again. The primary scheduled for March 8th has been pushed back to May 17th due to a ruling by the NC Supreme Court regarding the validity of new maps for NC's US House districts as well as NC General Assembly districts. Though the council district map is not impacted by this ruling, all elections have been delayed regardless of whether their maps are affected or not.

The #VoteLarken team had planned to file for one of the four Charlotte City Council At-Large seats last week, but the court ruling also paused the candidate filing period. While it is still unknown when filing will reopen and when the council's general election will be held, what we do know is this campaign is going to be longer and more expensive than we had planned for. We will keep you up to date as we receive more information from the board of elections and the courts, but in the meantime, if you're able, we'd greatly appreciate your help making sure our campaign is on strong financial footing as we update our team's strategy.
