And the Institute's Center for Professional Services offers consulting services to the public and private sector, helping to improve policies and pathways for diverse suppliers and help organizations commit to and achieve diversity, equity and inclusion. Co-locating these services in the PORTAL Building offers the Institute new visibility through a premier workspace and innovation center for regional and global business pioneers. It's an unusual combination, one not found on any other university campus in NC.
