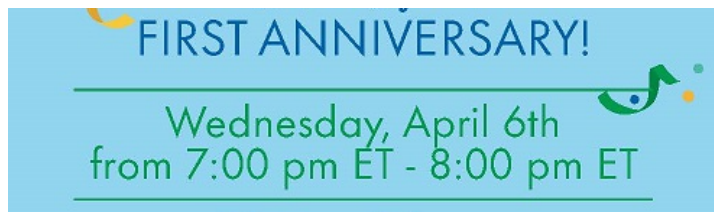


Dear Steve,
