We are just six weeks and a day from the May 17th primary for Charlotte City Council At-Large and two additional well-known candidates signed up in the final hours of the filing period in March, so our race is more competitive than we could have imagined. Thanks to you, we are in a great position to capture one of the four spots from the Democratic primary and advance to July's general election, but there is still much to be done and we'd love to have your help.

Ways you can help our campaign:

1) Tell a friend: Word of mouth endorsements were a huge part of our strategy for success in 2017 and 2019 and they will be again in this election. Anyone you know inside Charlotte city limits who is registered as a Democrat or Independent can vote in my election either on election day, May 17th, or during early voting which starts on April 28th. Whether you spread the word through face to face conversations with your friends, send out texts to folks you know are likely voters, or send out an email blast on my behalf, it will truly make a world of difference.
