In 2010, the Supreme Court single-handedly overturned more than a century of precedent in the landmark case, *Citizens United v. FEC*.

The 5-4 conservative majority ruling dramatically changed campaign finance laws by deregulating corporate spending, flooding our elections with dark money, and allowing the creation of Super PACs.

We support a Constitutional Amendment to reverse the Supreme Court's *Citizens United* decision and finally protect our elections from the unaccountable dark money, wealthy donors, and unfettered corporate spending that has the American people more disillusioned with the electoral process than ever before.
