The Mecklenburg County Delegation to the NC General Assembly Hosts its First Online Listening Session of the Year for Constituents

Raleigh, NC – The Mecklenburg County Delegation to the NC General Assembly will be hosting its first online Listening Session of the year this Thursday, April 21st, at 8pm. A majority of the Delegation's 17 members will be in attendance. This is an opportunity for constituents throughout the county to speak to their legislators. Constituents are encouraged to sign up to speak for up to 2 minutes about what issues they would like legislators to work on, concerns in their community, and reactions to legislative activity in the NCGA.

Senator Natasha Marcus, Chair of the Delegation, said, "As legislators, we are required to spend a lot of time in Raleigh, away from the communities we represent. We want to keep in touch with the folks who elected us and know what's on their minds. So we host regular listening sessions to be accessible to our constituents."

Press will not be permitted to ask questions during the Listening Session. This is an opportunity for the Delegation to hear from residents.
