<b>NOW</b> Absentee ballot requests are being accepted. Requests can be made <a href="#">online or by mail</a> .	<b>APRIL 28 - MAY 14</b> One-stop, in-person early voting period
<b>MAY 10</b> Deadline to submit an absentee ballot request form	<b>MAY 17</b> Election Day and absentee ballot return deadline
