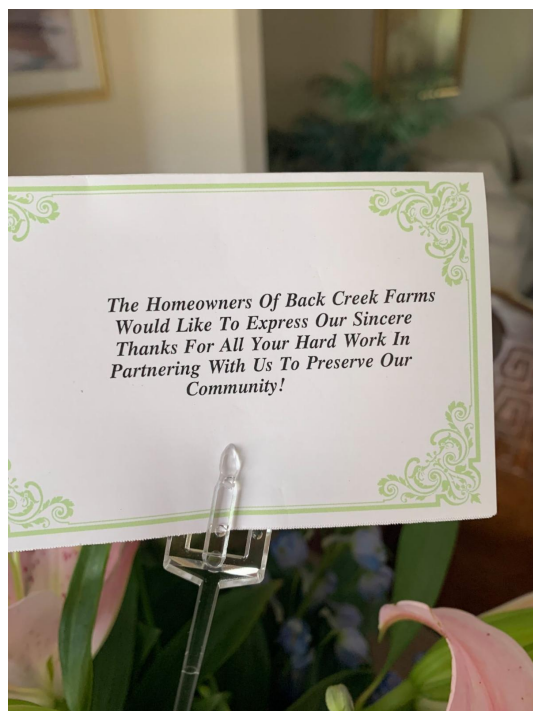

District 4 Residents, I am honored to serve on Charlotte's City Council as the first woman to represent District 4! I am running for re-election and need your continued support. Early voting runs from this Thursday, April 28th through May 14. The Primary Election will be held on May 17, 2022.


In 2019, I promised to fight for 3 things: Equitable Housing, Responsible & Strategic Development, and Public Accountability. You trusted me then, and I have kept my promises!

I have been a consistent advocate for affordable housing while advocating for the preservation of single family subdivisions. I

opposed the City's 2040 Comprehensive Plan because of the negative impacts on single family subdivisions that it may cause in the future. I have listened to the residents and raised the standard for development in District 4. I have negotiated for infrastructure improvement and investment in our area. District 4 is now the 2nd largest employment area in the city with over 4,000 new jobs created during my term. I have demanded MORE in District 4!

## Redistricting News... Welcome Precinct 211 - Hornet's Nest

On November 15, 2021, City Council approved a redistricting plan for City Council districts. The plan balances the populations of each district to ensure district populations are equally represented on the City Council — a legal principle known as "one person, one vote."
