Initially launched in response to the civic unrest that erupted in Charlotte in the fall of 2016, Unite Charlotte provides operating funding and capacity-building support to local grassroots organizations advancing racial equity and addressing economic mobility.

United Way of Central Carolinas will launch its 2023 Unite Charlotte First Year application process on **May 16, 2022**.

The first step in the application process is the Letter of Interest (LOI), which is due on **June 3, 2022, at noon**.

Agencies interested in applying for Unite Charlotte funding are encouraged to attend the upcoming information session, covering applicant eligibility and the application process.

Registration is required.
