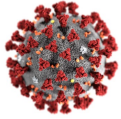

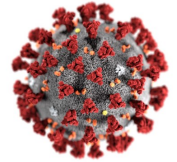

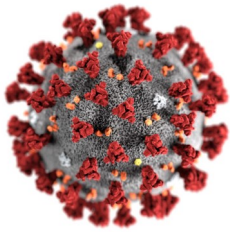

Absentee One-Stop a.k.a Early Voting

Any voter registered in Mecklenburg County may choose to vote in person using One-Stop Absentee Voting which begins the third Thursday before the election and ends the Saturday prior to the election. You may register and vote at any early voting location. You do not have to go to an assigned location.

Dates, times, and locations vary by election and will be posted prior to each election on this site.

Early Voting for the Primary Election to be held May 17, 2022 began Thursday, April 28, 2022 and will end Saturday, May 14, 2022 at 3 pm.

Details will be posted as soon as available. The Board approved 15 sites - exact locations are still to be determined.
