BIPARTISAN SAFER COMMUNITIES ACT



- Closes the "boyfriend loophole"
- Strengthens background checks for buyers under age 21
- Bolsters crisis intervention programs and red flag laws
- Expands child and family mental health services
- Clarifies who is considered a "gun seller"
- Establishes new criminal offenses for gun trafficking

Congress passed the Bipartisan Safer Communities Act this week – the most significant new gun safety bill since the 1990s which President Joe Biden signed into law.

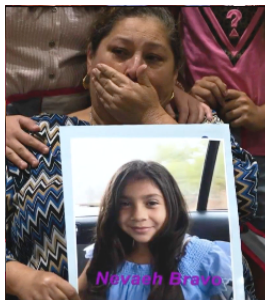
