The UNC Charlotte STEM Pre-College Program is currently accepting applications for Fall 2022 for middle and high school students with an interest in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics. The goal of the program is to broaden the pool of traditionally-minoritized students pursuing STEM majors and careers. Its objectives are met via enrichment activities on and off the campus of the University of North Carolina at Charlotte primarily through: a Saturday Academy during the academic year; a Summer Scholars program annually in June/July; a research experiences program; and in-person/virtual interactions with STEM professionals. Enrollment is currently underway until September 30, 2022.
