### **Employer Engagement Center**

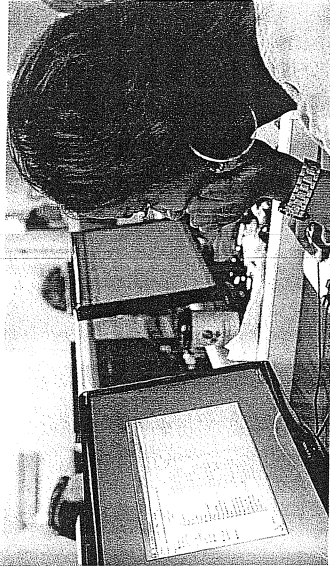
The Employer Engagement Center (EEC) offers a unique setting where job seekers and employers have access to resources and training specifically designed to develop and connect workforce talent with the current and future needs of Charlotte area businesses. Resources include coaching, workshops, and networking for job seekers; and recruitment opportunities for employers.



### **Charlotte Works**

Charlotte Works, formerly the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Workforce Development Board, is a private/public partnership bringing together Charlotte area resources to educate, empower and engage Charlotte's workforce to meet current business climate needs.

For job seekers, Charlotte Works provides customized training and resources at targeted locations throughout Mecklenburg County designed to develop and align talent with the changing needs of Charlotte area employers. Resources vary in level of depth by location. Current sites include the Employer Engagement Center on West Morehead near Uptown, the JobLink Center on South Boulevard and more than 20 SNAP (Shared Network Access Points) throughout Mecklenburg County.



### **JobLink Centers**

JobLink Centers have traditionally served as one-stop career centers for job seekers looking for employment. The five centers have been consolidated to two campuses, one on South Boulevard managed by Goodwill Industries of the Southern Piedmont, and the Employer Engagement Center on West Morehead. Combined resources and staff provide improved efficiency and accountability, as well as, expanded services to meet the needs of Charlotte job seekers by supporting training and development that meet the criteria of Charlotte area employers.

### **SNAP sites**

SNAP (Shared Network Access Points) sites are collaborations with targeted area community partners that extend Charlotte Works' resources into local neighborhoods and within faith-based organizations. The goal is to offer job seekers convenient access to the resources needed to find work. Each SNAP site is equipped with computers, software, and staffed by volunteers.
