The Urban League of Central Carolinas has expanded into east Charlotte.

The Digital Innovation Center is officially open to the public.

The grand opening was held August 10 in East Town Market to a crowd of county and city officials, school board members and community partners all with a vested interested in this expansion to the east side.

This satellite location is a collaboration between Urban League of Central Carolinas (ULCC) and Mecklenburg County in support of CareerBridge/WTB (Working Women, Thriving Families, Better Communities) – ULCC's workforce development program which provides the community with the skills, tools and certifications needed for high-demand careers.

Teddy McDaniel, president and CEO of ULCC opened the program. A welcome was given by Todd Collins, CEO of Red Hill Ventures and remarks were given by the following speakers: Mark Jerrell, Mecklenburg County Commission, District 4, Dr. Kinneil Coltman, ULCC Board Chair and Atrium Health's, Senior Vice President, Chief Community and Social Impact Officer, Dr. Fahnie Shaw, Chief Operating Officer of ULCC and Kathleen Evans, AT&T Regional Director, External Affairs.

Evans presented ULCC with a check for \$25,000, an award made through AT&T Connected Learning, a national initiative to narrow the digital divide by providing today's learners with equitable opportunity to learn and thrive.

The program concluded with a ceremonial ribbon cutting and tour of the facility.

The Digital Innovation Center is a state-of-the-art facility offering CareerBridge/WTB classes in Universal Banking, Amazon Web Services and Microsoft Office among others.
