**Meet Matieyos** 

Today, Matieyos is a Building Engineer for CBRE, but just last year, he was working as an Uber driver.

Several years ago, Matieyos was in nursing school but dropped out due to family issues. He pivoted and became a truck driver, but being away from his wife and two teenage children on a regular basis eventually took its toll. From there, he began driving for Uber.

## Finding Goodwill University & Taking Courses

One day, a person riding with Matieyos told him that he had taken classes with <u>Goodwill University</u> and found success.

Matieyos asked the passenger, "Goodwill has classes? How do you get them?"

His passenger emphasized that not only were <u>Goodwill University's training</u> <u>courses</u> good, but they were also free. Matieyos decided to email Goodwill, and within a couple of days, he was signed up to start the <u>Construction Basics</u> <u>course</u>.

"I liked the [Construction Basics] class because it just opened the door for me. That class would have cost a lot if I went to trade school; it's not cheap," Matieyos said.

Training courses, like the one Matieyos took, are available free of charge thanks to donations and purchases made by shoppers at <u>Goodwill retail</u>

<u>locations</u>. He was so impressed with Goodwill's Construction Basics course that he also enrolled in its <u>HVAC course</u>.

## **Utilizing Other Career Services**

After completing his courses, Matieyos began working with his Goodwill Career Navigation Coach and Goodwill's Employee Engagement Team to build his resume and find a career in the construction and trade industry.

"We do a lot of hands-on training that leads to certifications," Marvin Kelley, director of the <u>Construction and Trade Skills Training Program</u>, said. "And really, with our coaching and our employability, we're really preparing folks for an opportunity and industry."

A job fair set up at the <u>Goodwill Construction Skills Training Center</u> helped Matieyos land his current position with CBRE, where he oversees four buildings for the company - checking the interior and exterior, and making sure they are safe for everyone. He is currently working with his supervisor to train to become a Lead Building Engineer.

## Launching His Career

In just a matter of months, his life trajectory was changed. Matieyos began his first course in September 2021 and was able to gain employment by January 2022.

Matieyos has expanded his construction education since starting with Goodwill, but he's not done yet. He plans to take an <u>Electrical course</u> with Goodwill in September.

Matieyos encourages anyone who needs help with their career to take advantage of the classes Goodwill provides, gain knowledge and make themselves valuable in their industry of choice.

"I invite a lot of people to join in these classes. This is the best opportunity," he emphasized.
