Pay Attention to the Midterm Elections People

Most of us, as voters, pay a lot of attention to the presidential election cycles. This is understandably so. The president has a lot of power; the position is glamorous and holds our attention. The president of the USA is also, after all, the leader of the free world. But there are other elections, which, while not as glamorous, are equally essential for us to consider as voters.

The midterm elections are just as important because these elections determine who controls the U.S. Congress and governorships. According to CNN.com, "The Democrats' majority in Congress is razor-thin: The Senate is a 50-50 split (with Vice President Kamala Harris' tie-breaking vote giving them the advantage), and Speaker Nancy Pelosi's control of the House rests on a slim margin. In 2022, all 435 House seats and 35 of the 100 Senate seats are on the ballot.

Additionally, 36 out of 50 states will elect governors." What needs to be understood here is that while the presidential election determines who heads and wields the executive power of the federal government, the midterm elections determine who speaks for the states on the national level.



And it should also be noted that the states have a lot of decision-making power in Congress. In other words, Congress is made up of delegates from the states. They are put into power to represent their states in Congress. Couple this with governors who make

decisions on a state level, and you have the recipe for why you need to pay attention.

It should also be noted that Congress places a check on the power of the presidency. If the opposing party holds control of Congress—more specifically, if the Democratic Party loses control of Congress—it could make it more difficult to pass bills that Democrats consider a priority. Checks and balances deliberately make it so, but in our era of bitter partisan division, a divided government can be a mean one.

Many of the issues that concern us are decided at the state level, too. This includes abortion rights (i.e., since the overturn of Roe vs. Wade), climate change, healthcare, voter suppression, and other issues. Still, according to the UAB Institute for Human Rights Blog, "midterm elections historically have 10-20% lower voter turnout than presidential elections." The fewer people who vote in an election, the less likely that election outcomes will represent the will of most of the American people. When you don't vote, you are essentially taping your mouth shut.



The American people are also living in a time of the resurgence of far-right extremism. If the American people do not vote, then it is possible that they will get representatives from those who did

vote, who are also extreme and dangerous for American democracy. One can look at all the chaos that Donald Trump caused as president. There is a very real probability that MAGA Republicans may be able to win Congressional seats, not to mention governorships, and once again dig into implementing their extremist agenda.

Voting is still one of the best ways for your voice to be heard. Is your priority bashing immigrants and banning books, or is your priority affordable healthcare? This is important to consider because your vote will set Congressional priorities. So, pay attention to the midterm elections, people, and vote.
