**CONCORD, N.C.** (December 20, 2022) – **Congresswoman Alma Adams (NC-12)** will hold her annual “State of the District” and biannual “Ceremonial Swearing-In” on Thursday, January 19, 2023. Adams was elected to a 5th full term representing North Carolina’s 12th Congressional District in November.
