Breaking news, Steve: A panel of three federal judges just ruled that South Carolina legislators drew an illegal, racially gerrymandered First District that *may have cost Democrats a seat in Congress.*

Their ruling was clear:

"The movement of over 30,000 African Americans in a single county [Charleston County] from Congressional District No. 1 to Congressional District No. 6 created a stark racial gerrymander in Charleston County. The percentage of African Americans in Charleston County in Congressional District No. 1 fell from 19.8% at the time of the enactment of the 2011 plan to 10.3% in the 2022 plan."

Steve, illegal gerrymanders were *the* reason that House Republicans were able to barely claw their way back to the majority.
