THRIFTING IS GOOD FOR THE EARTH



There are many ways that donating and shopping at Goodwill help our planet, but this Earth Week, we want to highlight three in particular:

- When you donate and shop secondhand, you give items a second chance. We sold more than 17 million items in <u>our stores</u> and <u>online</u> last year – items that may have otherwise ended up in a landfill had they not been donated to us.
- Goodwill eliminates electronic waste. We <u>recycled</u> and refurbished nearly1.3 million pounds of electronics last year. Electronics that are donated in good working condition and items we're able to refurbish are sold at our tech store, <u>The GRID</u>. Items that we can't refurbish or resell are recycled responsibly.
- 3. It takes 1,800 gallons of water to grow enough cotton to make one pair of jeans. When you donate clothes you no longer want and buy secondhand items, you help preserve the planet's water supply.
