ICYMI: Mecklenburg County will hold an information session for organizations that provide substance use and mental health treatment services, early intervention, recovery housing, as well as employment and recovery services to combat the Opioid epidemic.

The session will be held on July 13, 2023, from 2 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. in Room 267 of the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Government Center (600 E. 4th St., Charlotte, NC 28202).

The purpose of this information session is to educate organizations about the application process, reporting and eligibility requirements to qualify for Mecklenburg County's Opioid Settlement funding. Please share this information with your stakeholder groups. This meeting is open to all interested organizations, and registration is not required.

More than \$6 million will be allocated through a competitive community proposal process. As part of the application process, the County will be accepting submissions for the following categories of opioid treatment and addiction-related services for FY24 and FY25:

- Employment-Related Services \$525,000
- Evidence-Based Addiction Treatment \$750,000
- Early Intervention \$750,000
- Recovery Support Services \$1 million
- Recovery Housing Support \$3 million

The online application portal for this funding will open on July 15, 2023. Organizations interested in implementing or expanding services with the grant funds are encouraged to attend the information session and will have until Aug. 15, 2023, to apply through the <u>online portal</u>.


