## MEET CHASITY

"I take things to Goodwill all the time, but I never really realized where it goes. And I'm thankful to everybody who donates because without them I wouldn't be here," said Chasity Spruill.

Chasity now works as a Programmer Analyst with Cognizant, but just a short time ago the IT professional was working as a teacher. She was seeking a career with more flexibility that would allow her more time with her kids.

"I don't even know if I could put it in the exact words. To see mommy stand up there and get recognized for all the hard work that I put in; they see me in the classes at night from six to nine and studying and to see that all of it is for something, it means so much," Chasity emotionally shared.

Today, Chasity is preparing for her upcoming nuptials and enjoying her new role with Cognizant, which provides her with more time with her kids in a fully remote position.
