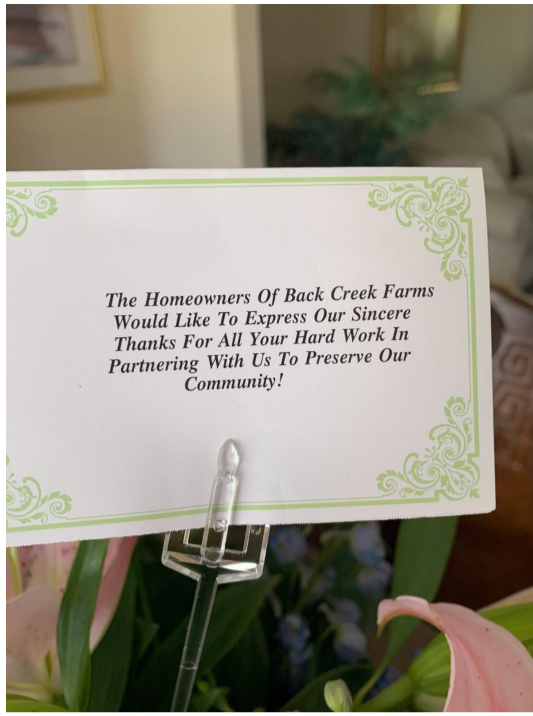

It also demonstrates the trust in my experience and willingness to stand for the people in which I have been unwavering since 2019.

As my record shows, I am unwilling to allow my position to be for sale or to succumb to the pressures of voting for personal interests. Additionally, I have established affordable housing solutions by providing transitional housing for homeless individuals through my non-profit organization, Triumph Services.
