## **Sol Nation Inc. Partners With CleanAire NC!**

After a year of frequently finding CleanAIRE NC in the same social and financial circles, it naturally led us to consider a more purposeful collaboration.

In order to create the type of environmental and climate justice impacts we need to see in our communities, we are going to have to collaborate. And, when I say collaborate, I am speaking of doing it in a way that is intentional, measurable, and accountable to the community we are serving. I am excited to announce that Sol Nation has officially partnered with CleanAire NC to have significant environmental justice impacts on the Historic West End all the way to eastern North Carolina. Jeff Robbins, Executive Director of Clean Aire NC, and I, have spent a good portion of 2023 building a relationship with each other and between our organizations. We were constantly finding ourselves in the same circles in community and in the funding world, so it only made sense that we do something more intentional with each other.



Our ultimate goal is to help communities have a safe, clean community that they can live in. Our partnership has identified some specific events that we will co-produce, such as Charlotte Earth Day 2024 and specific issues such as air quality (CleanAire NC is a leader in this issue area), reducing and mitigating emissions, and community engagement, particularly in predominantly Black and brown communities.




