




We are seeking your assistance to share FEMA's Historically Black Colleges (HBCU) and Universities and Minority Serving Institutions (MSI) summer internship opportunity.

FEMA is recruiting students from HBCUs and MSIs for the 2024 summer internship program. Students attending MSIs such as HBCUs and tribal colleges and universities are encouraged to apply.
