Rep. Alma Adams and Bipartisan HBCU Caucus to Host STEAM Days of Action April 17-18, 2024

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Congresswoman Alma S. Adams, Ph.D. (NC-12), a graduate of North Carolina A&T University and HBCU educator for four decades, along with the Congressional Bipartisan HBCU Caucus, will welcome attendees to the Seventh Annual STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math) Days of Action next week.

The two-day event will begin with a welcome reception on Wednesday, April 17, 2024, at 6:00 p.m., 2075 Rayburn HOB, Washington, DC 20001 and conclude on April 18, 2024 with a full day of programming around federal initiatives focused on HBCUs.
