HISTORY

- Money Magnets Club's programming and approach is birthed out of the experiences and practices of co-founder, Dr. Alexandra Arrington.
- Co-Founder Teresa Cain, a local children's librarian, helped to organize and inform the genesis of the organization at the West Boulevard branch of the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Library.
- Entrepreneurship and financial literacy learning are not as well attended to subjects for elementary schoolers. Money Magnets Club exists to fill that gap in Charlotte, NC areas that can benefit from it most.


HIGHLIGHTS IN ORGANIZATIONAL DEVELOPMENT

During the pandemic Money Magnets Club hosted virtual sessions and worked to support basic needs and create community in online settings.





PROGRAMS

Our signature kidpreneur-in-training program represents the heart of what we do: giving elementary students a baseline of learning with entrepreneurship and financial literacy concepts. Additionally we engage and support the local entrepreneurial ecosystem throughout out programming by having paid engagements to expose kids to the different ways that entrepreneurship can look. Our annual Fall Festival, Best of the West Entrepreneurship Fest (BOTWEF) highlights solopreneurs and microbusinesses serving in or on the West side. We hosted 39 program sessions for 2023 facilitating the connectivity of kids, responsible adults, program partners, financial services institutions, and guest entrepreneurs./kidpreneurs Young kids are our core and community is the lens through which we see and serve them.
