Charlotte Community Leaders Meet to Discuss Environmental and Social Injustice

Sol Nation Inc, CleanAIRE NC and the City of Charlotte, supported by the Knight Foundation, to kick off "Corridors of Opportunity; Greenprint".



Last Thursday, on June 6th, an assembly of community leaders and organizations convened in Charlotte to address the pressing matters of environmental, social, and climate injustices. The gathering delved into various issues including energy burden, housing equity, tree loss, and health concerns arising from pollution and inadequate facilities in specific regions. Through breakout sessions, these topics were thoroughly examined and discussed. As the meeting drew to a close, the participants agreed on the importance of educating the community and involving more community leaders and activists in the ongoing efforts to transform the 6 Corridors of Charlotte into a greener and more sustainable landscape.
